Many of our Assemblies of God missionaries were called to be missionaries while they were kids just like you! God wants you to keep your heart open to His call.

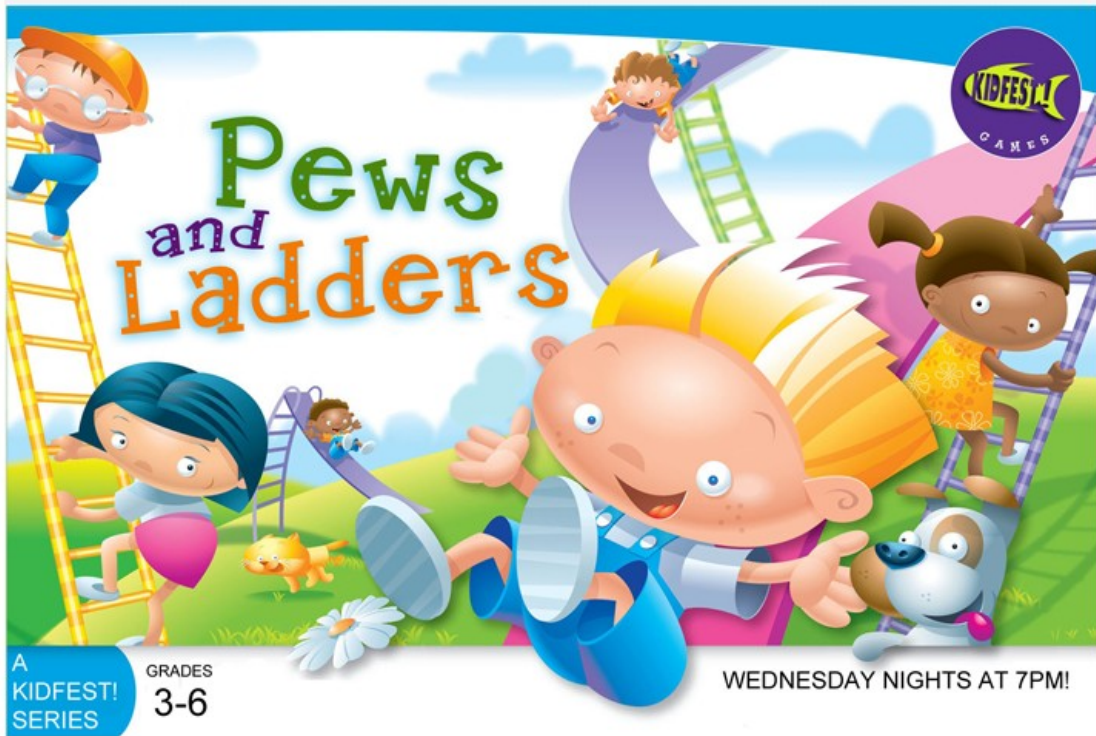
